

Operation Range Donation

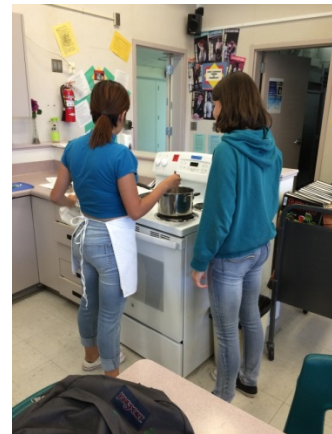
